RE: Community Development Committee Meeting

A Community Development Committee meeting has been scheduled for **Friday, June 19, 2015, at 12:00 pm in the City Council Chambers.**

**The purpose of this meeting is to review the applications for funding and also to review additional information provided from the private non-profit entities in regard to providing explanation on how the City of Minot would benefit from the expenditure of sales tax proceeds for the project or service (how the request is identified as an 'enterprise').**

## **AGENDA**

### **1. [Application Review](#) – Domestic Violence Crisis Center – New Beginnings Campus Project**

The Domestic Violence Crisis Center (DVCC) is requesting \$200,000 for their New Beginnings Campus Project which will help provide resources to support victims and children who have endured violence and abuse.

### **2. [Application Review](#) – City of Minot Municipal Auditorium – Facility Improvements**

The Minot City of Minot Municipal Auditorium is requesting \$1,050,000 to be used to enhance the seating, lighting and flooring in the main arena. The arena holds many community events to include basketball, volleyball, roller derby, auctions, concerts, weddings, dances, etc. The enhancements may be broken into phases and the city has prioritized the enhancements with the seating first at a cost of \$550,000. The lighting is second at a cost of \$150,000 and the flooring at a cost of \$350,000.

### **3. [Application Review](#) – City of Minot Sports Complex – Upper Parking Lot Reconstruction**

The City of Minot Sertoma Sports Complex is requesting \$1,518,000 to completely rebuild the upper parking lot along with a 2.5 inch overlay throughout the rest of the complex.

### **4. [Application Review](#) – Minot Park District – Jack Hoeven Complex Field Improvement**

The Minot Park District is requesting \$1,600,000 for artificial turf for one of the full baseball fields at the Jack Hoeven Complex. An artificial turfed field would mean area teams could start play almost a month sooner than is possible with the current field.

**5.     [Application Review](#) – Minot Park District –MAYSA – Expansion of Third Ice Rink**

The Minot Park District is requesting \$1,000,000 for expansion of a third rink at the MAYSA Arena. The request is for additional dollars because the scope of the project has been adjusted to better fit the needs of the growing community.

**6.     [Application Review](#) – Minot State University – Herb Parker Stadium – Seasonal Multisport Air Dome**

Minot State University is requesting \$1,000,000 for the purchase and installation of a seasonal air-supported multisport dome at Herb Parker Stadium on the campus of Minot State University. The air-supported structure would be installed over the current turf at the stadium in mid-November with it being removed in late April.
